Complete a SAPS 55 (A) form at your nearest Police Station



Log onto www.missingchildren.org.za as soon as possible

Make sure you have all this information ready, to be able to complete the on-line form:

- Full name of the missing child
- Age of the missing child
- Most recent photo of the missing child
- What the child was last seen wearing
- Situation surrounding the child's disappearance
- SAPS Case number
- The SAPS details, including the name of the officer that assisted you



NB! Please keep Missing Children South Africa posted on any progress, or news of the missing child.
